The Charleston Sofa Super Store Fire- Rising from the Ashes of Tragedy

On June 18, 2007, the Charleston (SC) Fire Department suffered the loss of nine (9) firefighters during the tragic events of the Sofa Super Store fire. Following this event, Charleston Mayor Joe Riley enlisted the expertise of an outside panel to investigate the events of this tragic night and to analyze the operations of the Charleston Fire Department in relation to nationally recognized best practices and existing professional standards. This multi-media presentation will provide an overview of the events of June 18th and a detailed description of the Post-Incident Assessment and Enhancement Review Task Force recommendations and findings. This presentation promises to be an eye-opening session filled with transferable lessons for improving firefighter safety & survivability.
